

# Bags 4 Buczek - Tournament Rules

Throwing Order – To begin the game, play rock/paper/scissors to determine which team goes first. From that point forward, the team that scores in the previous half-inning will get to throw first. Teams will alternate turns, until all 8 bags have been thrown.



Player Positions – In doubles, one member of each team will throw from opposite boards. Teammates will be positioned on the same side of the playing area (see diagram below).


Pitcher's Box – Players must remain in the Pitcher's Box while pitching bags. The Pitcher's Box is 3' wide X 4" long (see diagram below).

Innings – In doubles play, there is a top and bottom half of an inning, just like baseball. A game cannot end in the middle of an inning. Each game will be played until the first team reaches or exceeds 21 at the completion of a full inning. The winning team does not have to win by 2 or more points.

Cancellation Scoring – Once each team throws their 4 bags, the points are added up and the team with more points gets the difference in the score. Example: Team A scores 7 points, Team B scores 2; the resulting score for Team A is 5 points. Team B does not get any points.

1. Bags in the hole: 3 points.
2. Bags on the board: 1 point.

Faults - Bags that hit the ground and bounce on to the board, do not count and must be removed before the next bag is thrown. Players may not cross the front edge of the board when throwing a bag.



Bring your own bags option – Bags will be provided, but players may bring their own bags. Bags must be between 5½-6 inches square. Tourney director has final say in approving bags if there is a dispute. Pro Series "Stop-n-Go" bags are available for purchase.
